MOTIVATION & GOAL

- Poor implementation & enforcement of environmental legislation
 - ✓ System needs multiple reforms
- General goal: improve implementation & enforcement



PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Improve legislation related to environmental inspection
- Propose changes to inspection-related institutional framework
- Change planning approach → risk assessment
- Prepare/support elaboration of tools for inspectors:
 - ✓ Website
 - ✓ Information Management System
 - ✓ Guides for inspectors and for industrial operators
 - ✓ Checklists
- Raise capacity through a training programme
